Doreen Mary Sutherland Legacy

In 2017, we received over \$180,000 from the Estate of Doreen Sutherland. At our AGM of May, 2017 we voted on establishing five new scholarships in her name, three at UVIC and two at Camosun for a total of \$155,000 in endowed funds. These funds will start awarding funds to students this year. We still have about \$27,000 left to be used for another award. We are in discussions with Camosun for an award in their Access programme.

Diana Morgan Legacy

We received \$50,000 from the Estate of Diana Morgan. With \$25,000 of these funds, we set up a scholarship that received matching funds in the Faculty of Humanities. Our previous awards that we have set up have been in the Sciences, one in Exercise, Physical and Health Education and one in the Faculty of Human and Social Development. The Faculty of Humanities comprises Departments of English, French, Gender Studies, Other Language Studies, History, Linguistics, Philosophy, and many other areas. It covers a lot of smaller departments which would not normally have awards specific to them. There still are matching funds available and so we will contribute the balance of the funds to this scholarship so that we can pay out two awards of \$2,000 each annually.

Annual Disbursements

At this point, our club supports 35 awards (up from 33 last year) at the three post-secondary institutions in Victoria: 16 at the University Of Victoria; 4 at Royal Roads University and 15 at Camosun College. This year, our funds disbursed about \$43,000.

As usual, we have received very generous donations to our funding from several sources: member stipends, smile cards, flower sales, and, most particularly, very generous contributions from our members. And of course, our legacies. They really make a difference. Our funds at the foundations of the three institutions now total over \$1,300,000. We are very grateful!

Unfortunately we had to cancel our lunch this year due to weather. There was a lot of work put into this and so it was with regret that the lunch was cancelled. The S&B Committee is thinking of alternatives for next year – perhaps a different month and/or venue.

The S&B Board is appointed by the Club Executive on the recommendation of the Board. Traditionally the Chair of S&B has been a past president of the Club. So I am pleased to announce that Brenda Canitz will be the new Chair of S&B. *(Brenda, would you please stand up.)*
